TIMBER!

The College of Central Florida is starting a new Timber Harvesting Equipment program this month. The eight-week noncredit program will cover a variety of topics, including:

- Basic forest management
- Timber harvesting operations
- Silvicultural and wildlife best management practices
- Timber harvesting safety
- Basic operation of a feller-buncher, skidder and loader

The program runs from May 8 – June 30, 2017 and full tuition scholarships. The timber industry is vital to Levy County, with 724,035 acres of timberland in the county. In the region, paper manufacturing accounts for a \$350-million economic output, while wood products account for \$75-million.
