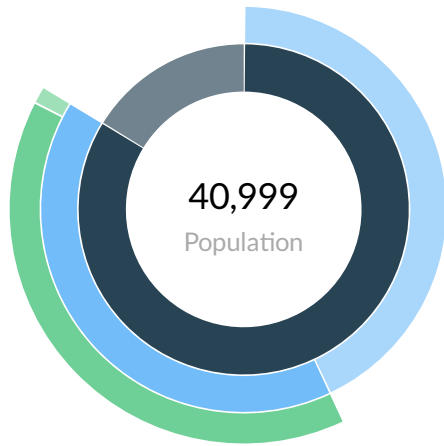
Median household income is **\$22.7K below** the national median household income of \$60.3K.

- From 2014 to 2019, jobs **increased by 10.3%** in Levy County, FL from 9,566 to **10,549**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 7.6% by 2.7%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 49.1% to 48.7% between 2014 and 2019**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.0% of Levy County, FL residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.8% below the national average), and **8.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2019 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

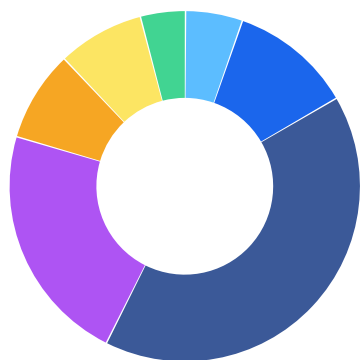

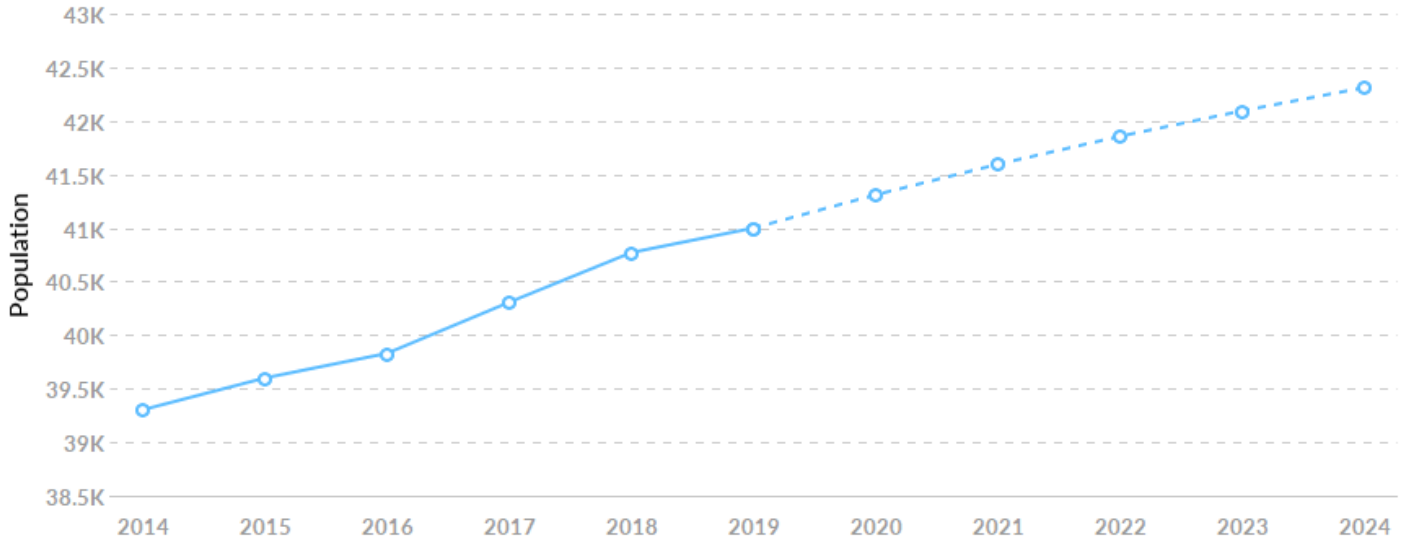

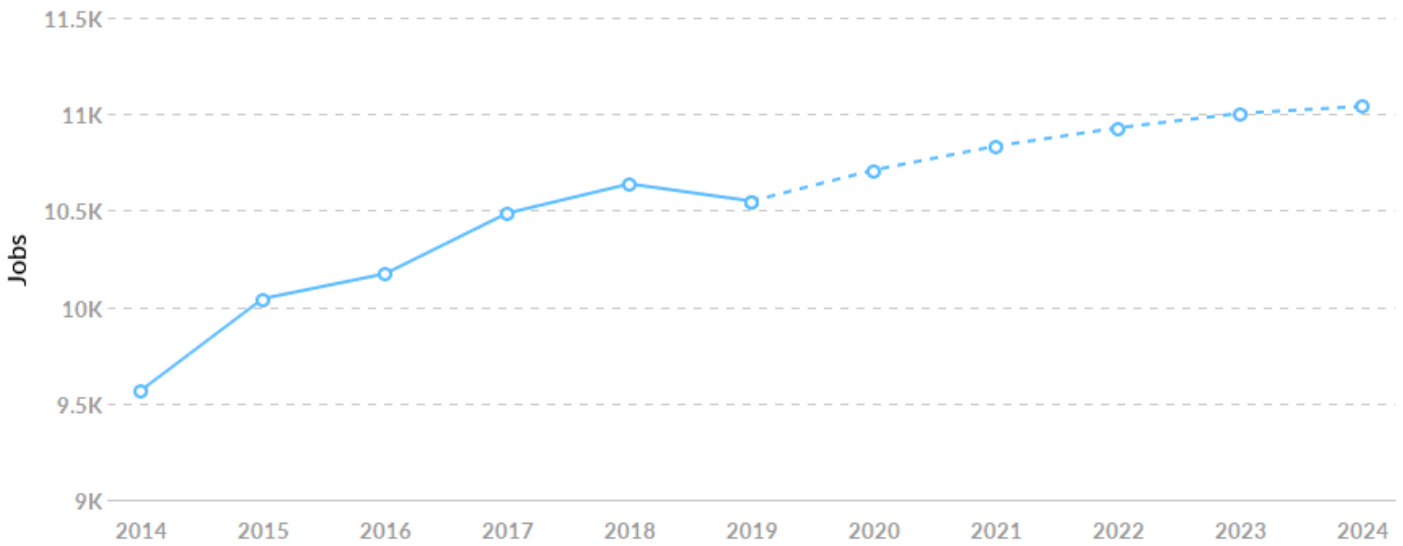

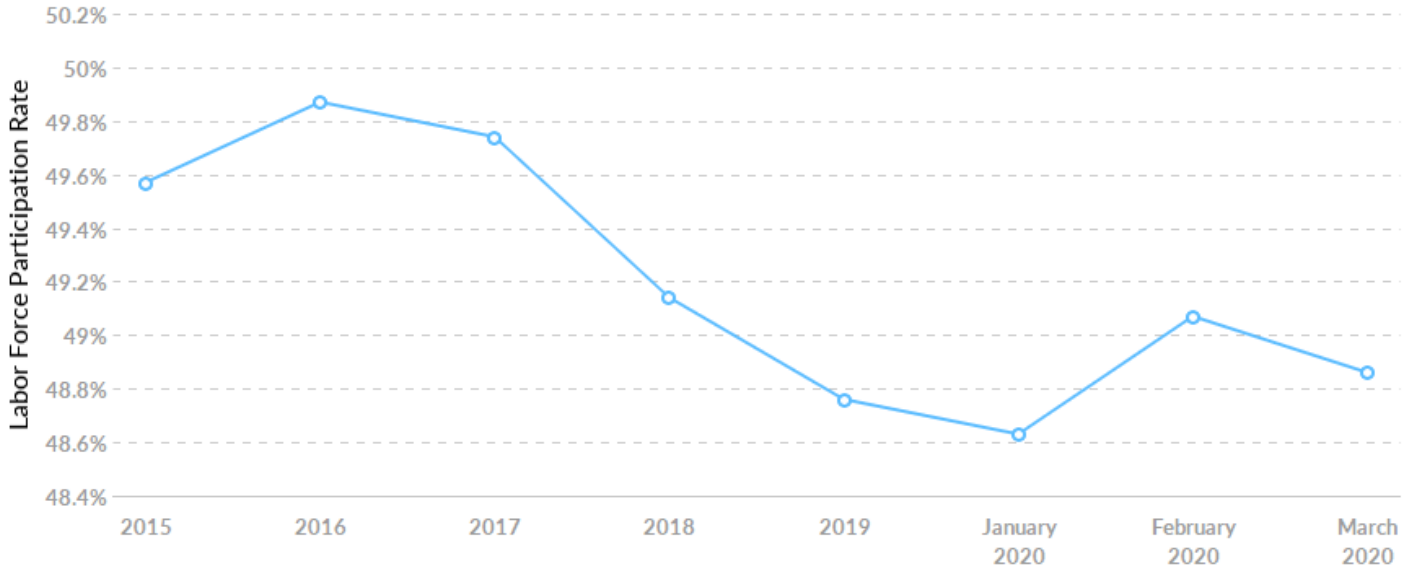
Job Trends

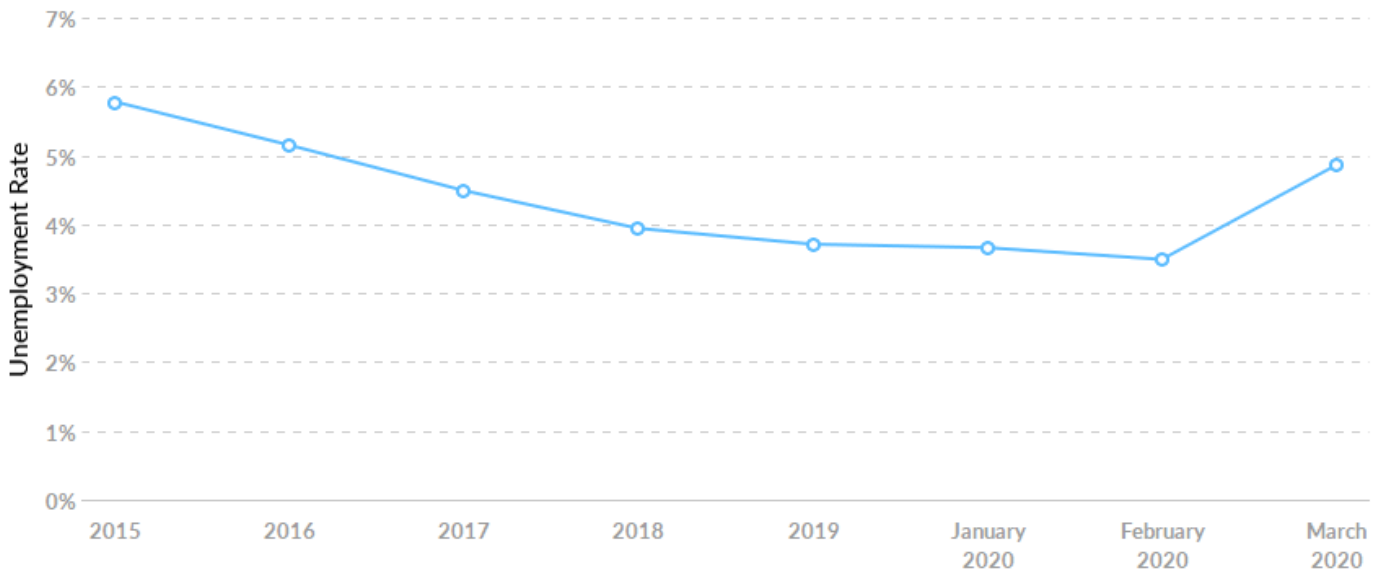

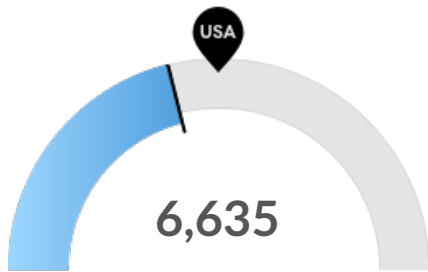
Unemployment Rate Trends

Levy County, FL had a March 2020 unemployment rate of 4.86%, **decreasing from 5.78%** 5 years before.



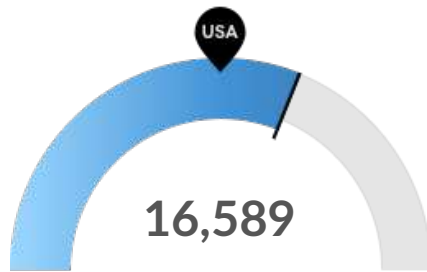

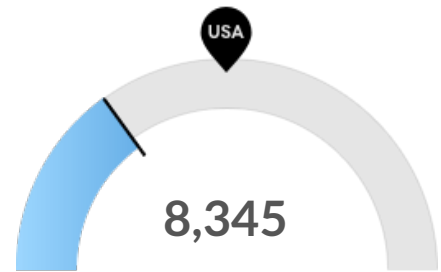
Millennials

Levy County, FL has 6,635 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 8,382.



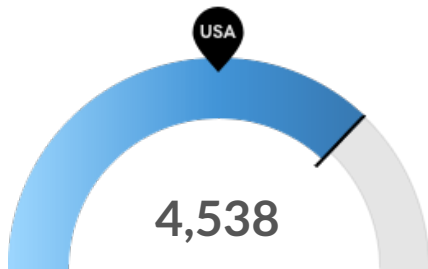
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Levy County, FL. The national average for an area this size is 11,802 people 55 or older, while there are 16,589 here.



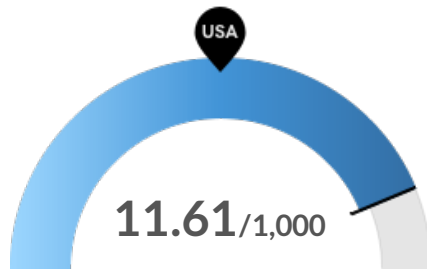
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Levy County, FL. The national average for an area this size is 16,153 racially diverse people, while there are 8,345 here.



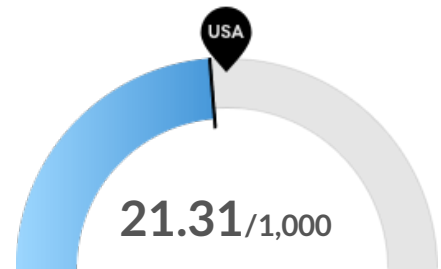
Veterans

Levy County, FL has 11.61 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.87 per 1,000 people.

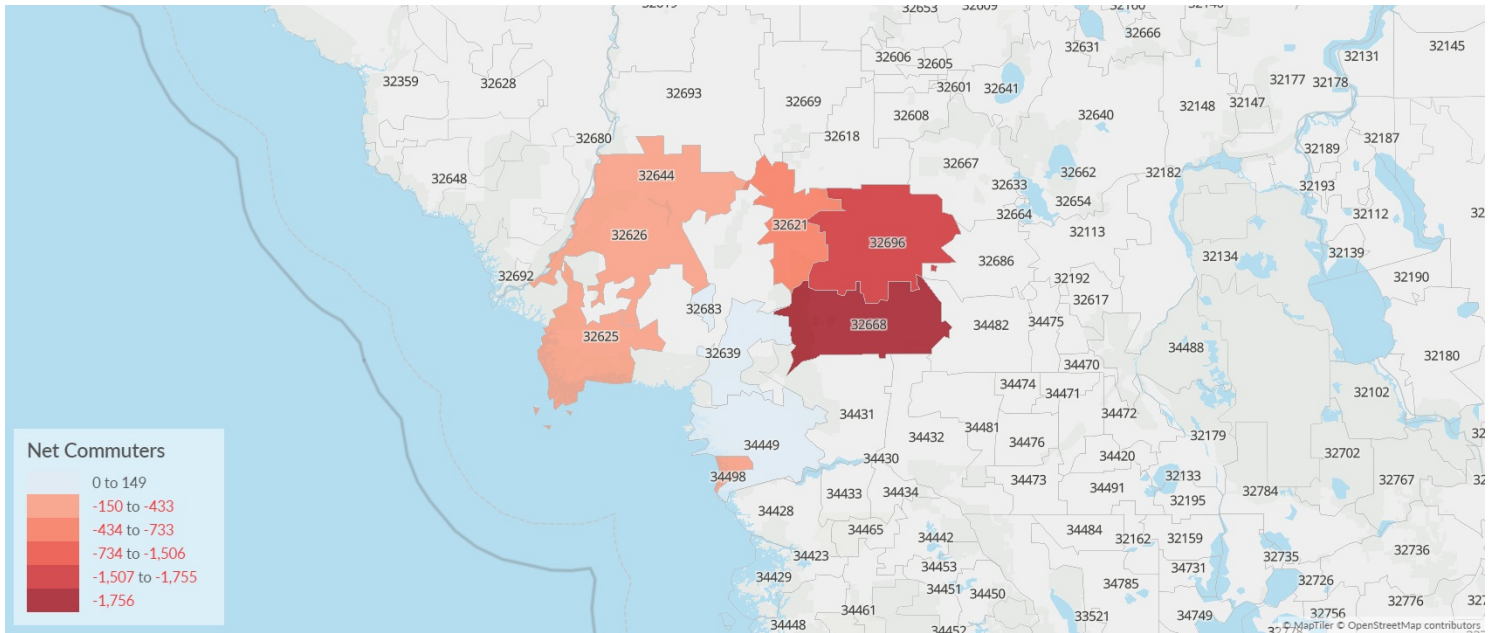


Property Crime

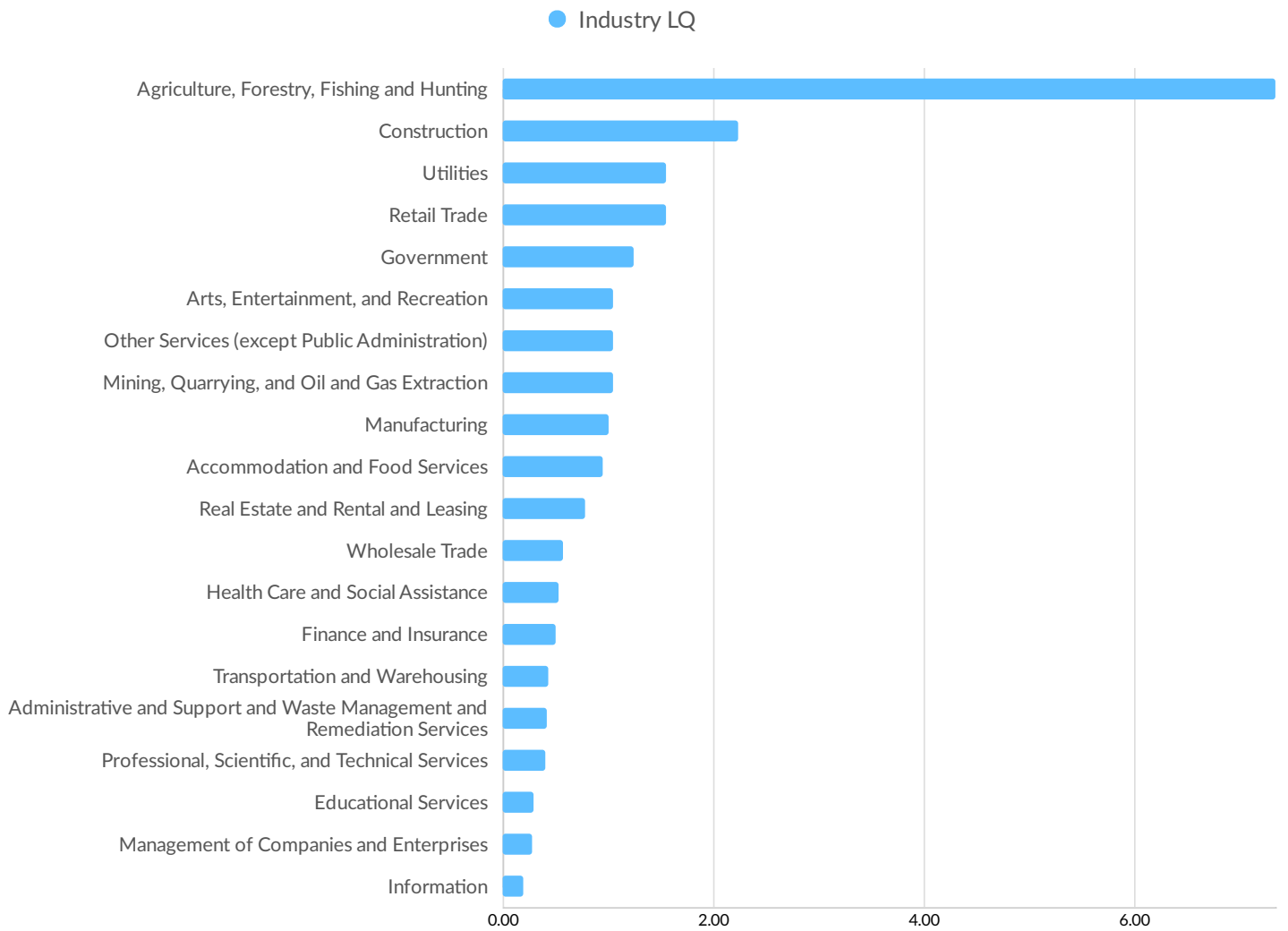

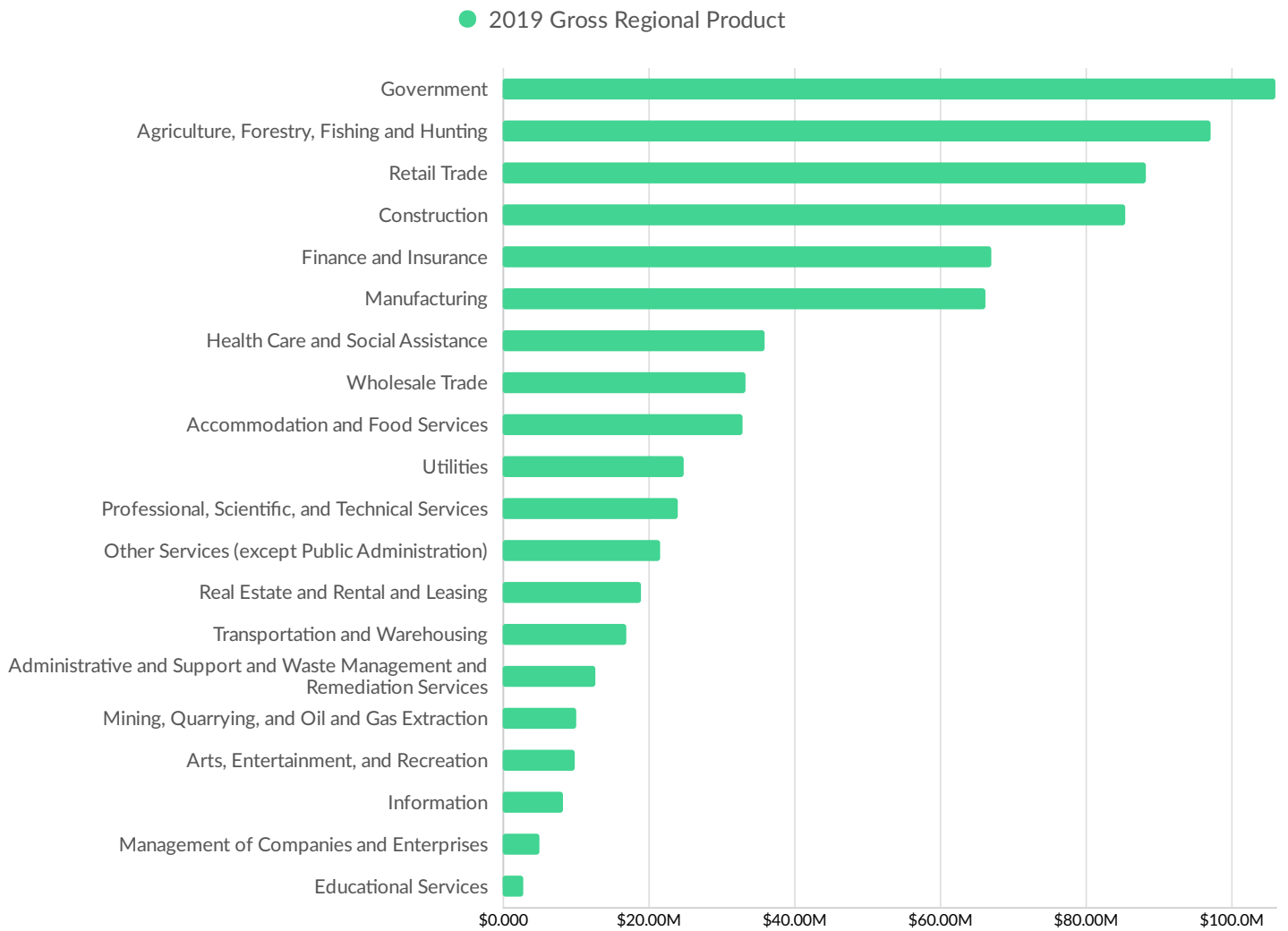

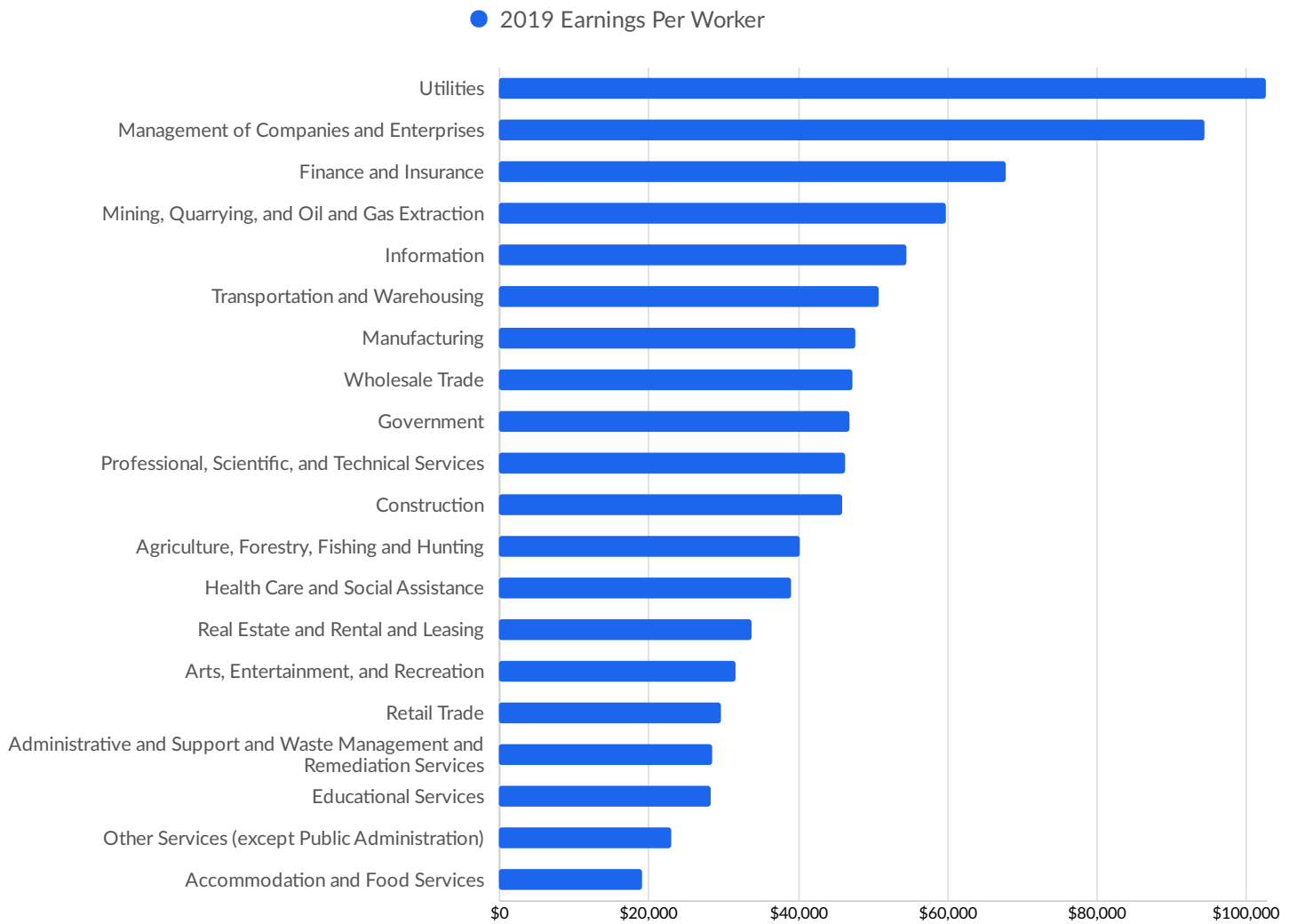

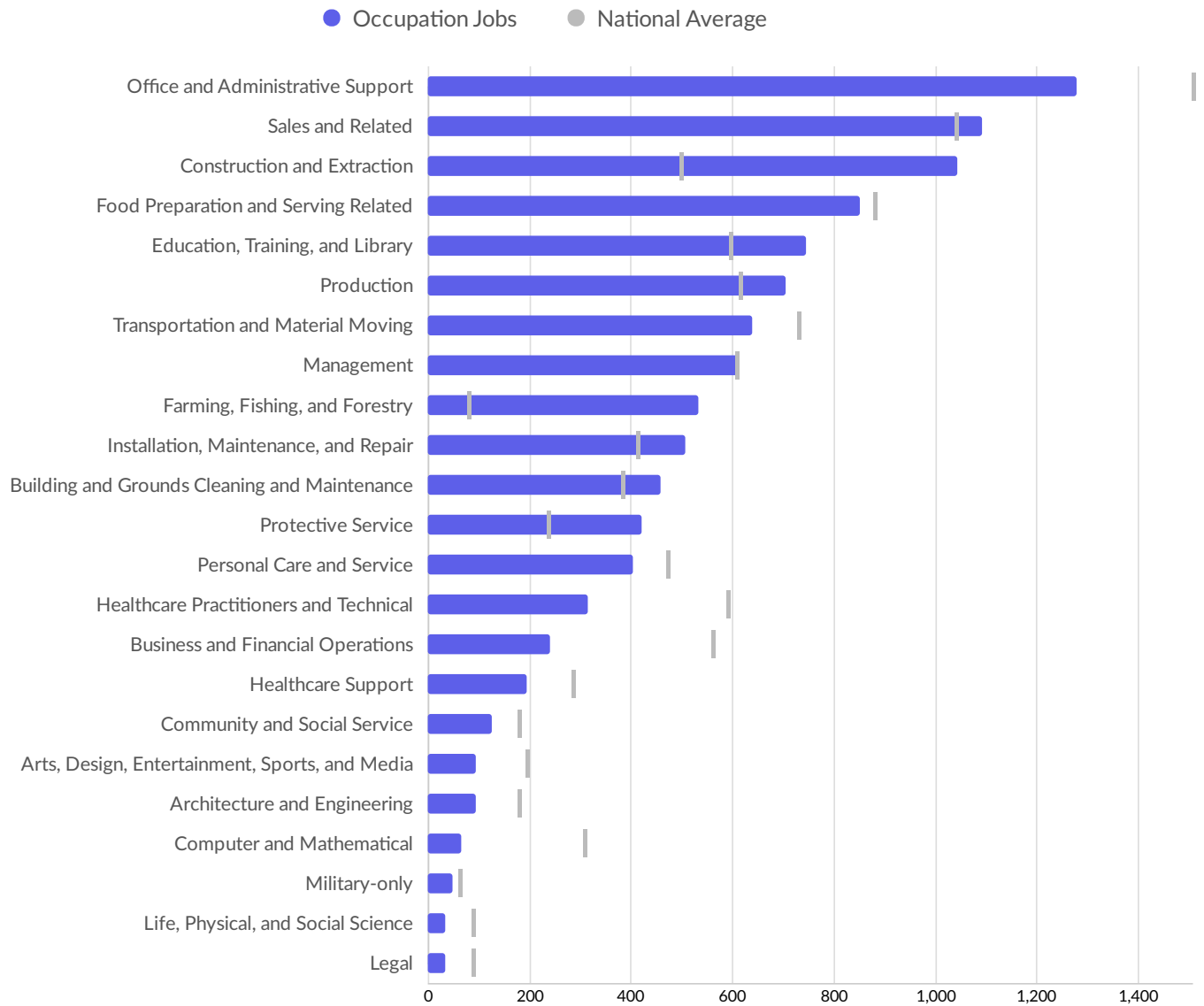

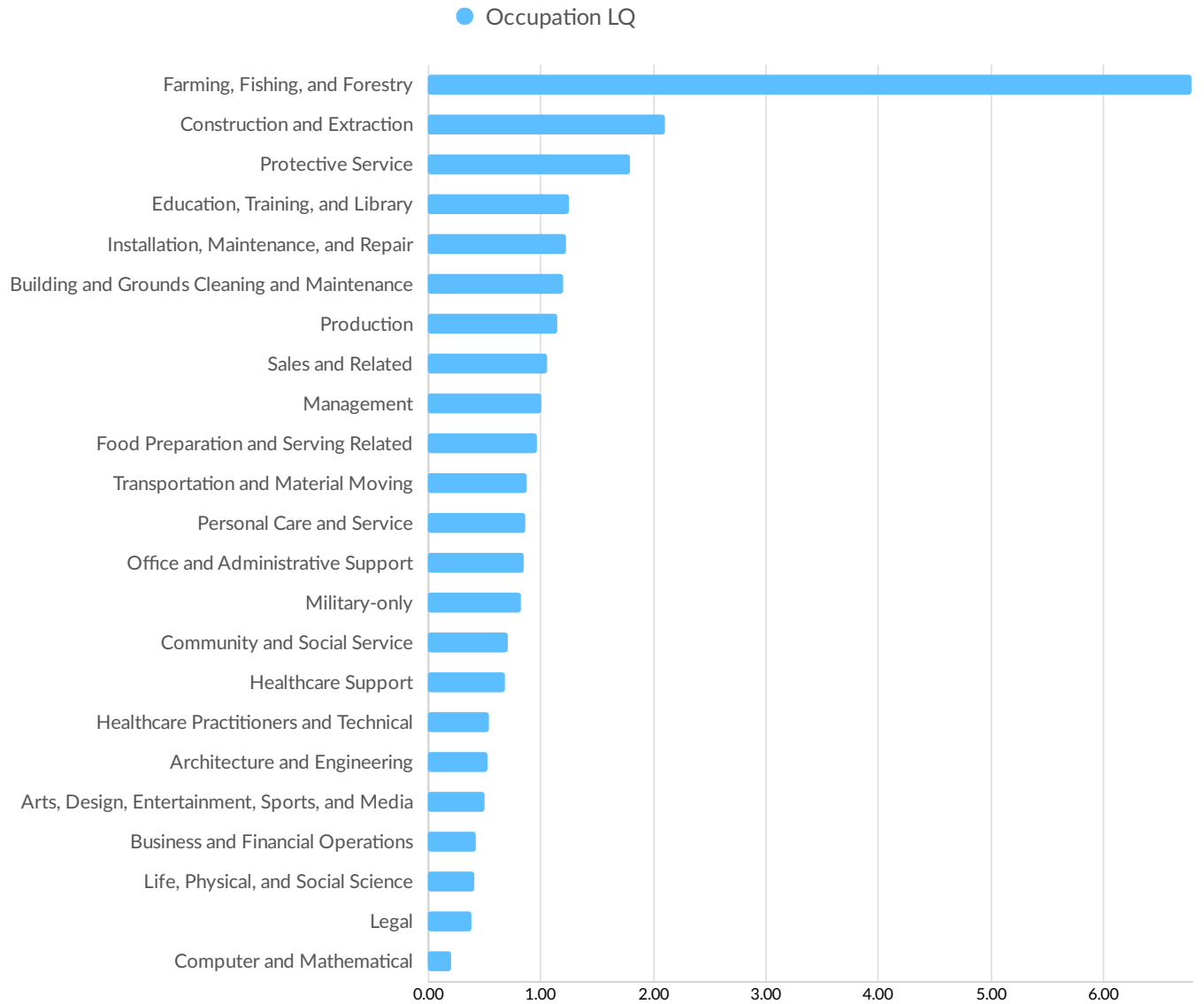

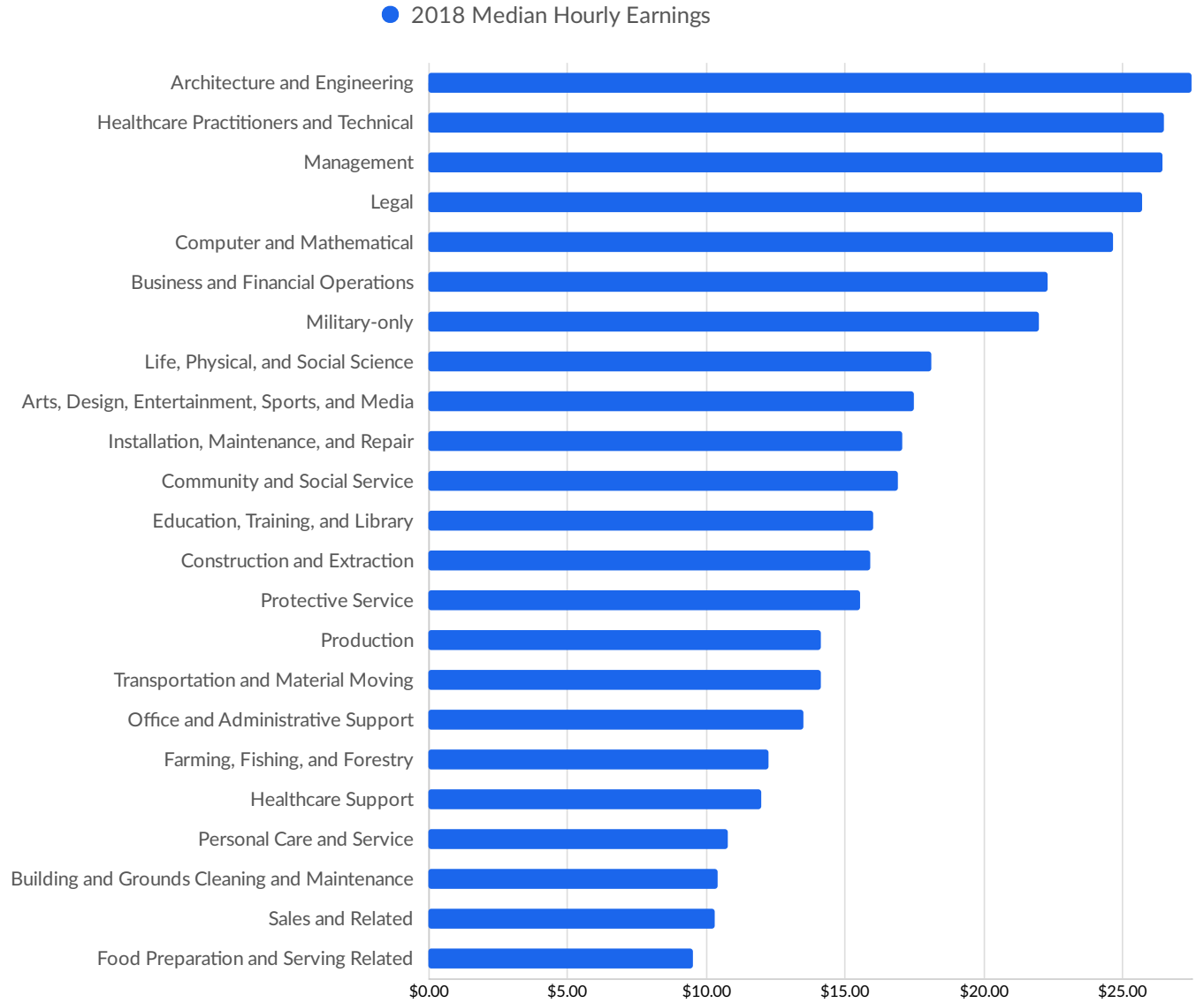

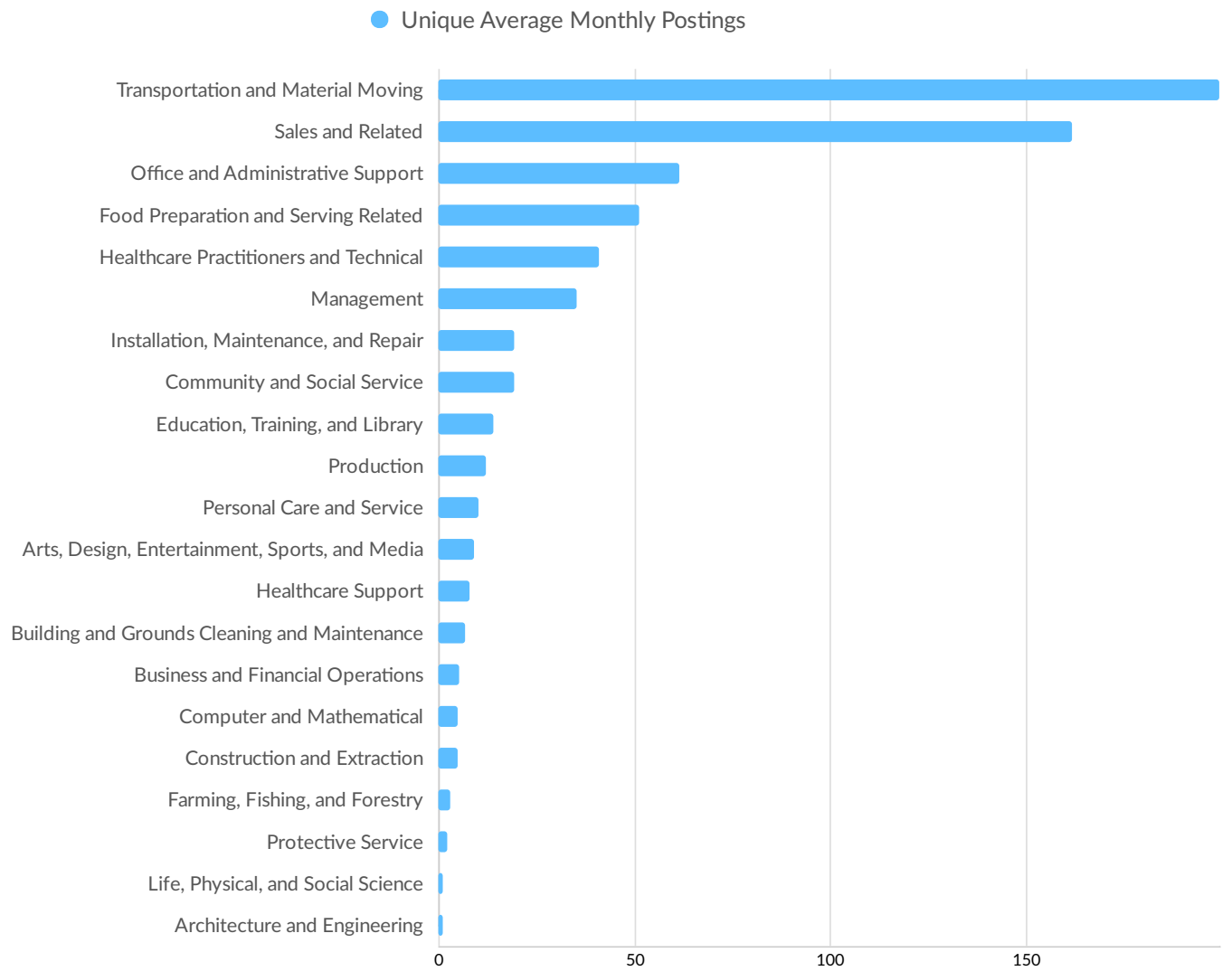

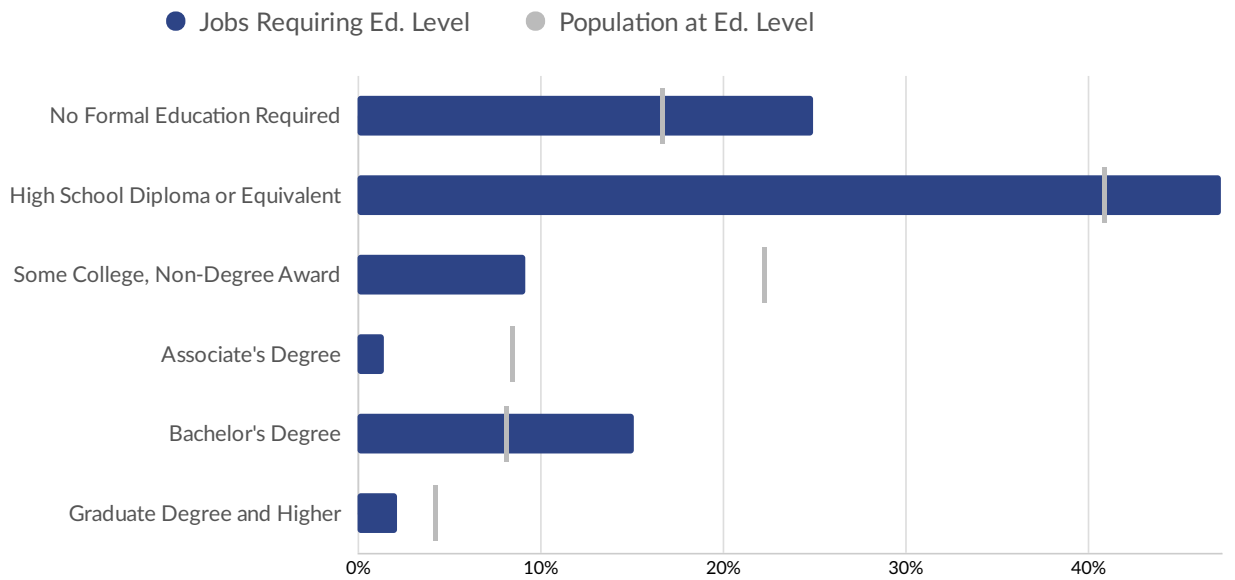
